I BELIEVE GOD

FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR DAVID C. FORBES, JR.



“ You must be willing
to decree by faith - I believe GOD! ”

Having confidence in God and being courageous about who you are in this Christian life is very important. You are a Breakthrough Believer. This means you have a prevailing kingdom mentality and you are dynamic, energetic, world-overcoming, Holy Ghost empowered and supernaturally effective. Average Christians believe what they see; but here are three words that will change your life:

I believe God!

As your Pastor, I have to tell you the whole truth - I believe God! He has a good track record. Everything He ever said, He's done. He has never let me down. He has been better to me than I have been to myself. I have no reason or justification to doubt the God I serve.

Christians must understand that in life there are going to be moments, situations or seasons that are distasteful. During these contrary moments, you must be willing to decree by faith - I believe God! Yes, it may be uncomfortable, but you have to know that there is a word from God for your situation. His Word declares, “Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but God delivers him out of them all.” (Psalm 34:19) You might as well face it - unfair treatment, lies or contradictions of life will occur. However, God will deliver you out of every single one of them.

1 John 5:13-15 says, “These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him.”

In the midst of your challenges, God will show Himself strong on your behalf. Wait on the Lord and be of good courage, He will strengthen your heart. (Psalm 27) Remember, victory is yours because you believe God and act on His Word.

As You Believe God:

1. You must have confidence in Him.
2. You must have confidence that you can ask anything according to His will.
3. If you ask anything according to His will, you must have confidence that He hears you.
4. Since God hears you, you must have confidence that you will receive exactly what you ask.

During Kingdom College, Pastor Forbes has been dealing with the importance of "Renewing Your Mind" Romans 12:2. This realization is central to being an effective Christian and a Breakthrough Believer. Why? Choices are made in the mind, and the mind is a part of your soul.

The soul contains our thoughts, will, emotions, and memories. In the soul we comprise the way we think and feel. So then, our thoughts and feelings start to shape our attitude. Our attitude then determines our belief system, which you can also label your worldview.

Our worldview determines how we deal with life. For instance, our views affect how we vote, how we handle money, pressures and responsibilities. Further it affects our attitudes about race, politics and relationships. In these few examples...

Our choices shape our life, and we want a life that reflects Christ.


God has given us the ability to choose. The first opportunity for man to choose was in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 2:8-9; 15-17 and Genesis 3:1-7). Because of the choice Adam and his wife made, man was separated from God.

Another example of choice: Before Joshua and the Israelites go into the promise land, God implores them to "Choose Life..." (Deuteronomy 30:19). The blessing God provided to the children of Israel had to be chosen, which is an act of your mind.

Most importantly is the choice of Salvation. God said in His word that "... If you confess with your mouth, Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified..." (Romans 10:9-10) In order to "Believe in your heart" (where your spirit and soul merges together), you have to have an awareness or an understanding. This starts in the mind.

This is why it is so very important that your mind be renewed - transformed into a new way of thinking and understanding. The Word of God is what renews your mind. It is reading, studying and HEARING the word (Romans 10:17) that transforms your thinking.

LaunchPad is designed to provide entrepreneurs with the critical support they need after completing the planning phase of their business. Celebrating the Great Things God Has Done

WORD OVERDOSE

In May of 2012, I began to experience low back and hip discomfort. Because this discomfort had occurred before, I attempted to use the same stretching and exercise methods as in the past. This went on for more than a week. The stretches and exercises didn't work and the discomfort became pain. At this point, when I walked or stood, my upper body was tilted to the side.

More than a month went by and I still could not stand up straight. I began using various joint supplements to aid in the recovery. In addition to the supplements, I began to see a chiropractor. After x-rays, the chiropractor said I had arthritis in my hip and low back. Visits to the chiropractor went on for 2 months at 2-3 times/week with no improvement. Finally on the advice of my wife and mother, I went to see a sports medicine doctor. After more x-rays, this doctor said I had scoliosis of the spine and arthritis in the hip and low back. He suggested I receive physical therapy for six weeks. After six weeks of physical therapy at 2-3 times /week, I regained some flexibility but still could not stand up straight.

A second visit to the sports medicine doctor showed I had some improvement. He suggested six more weeks of physical therapy, with an emphasis on core work. We did core work for a few weeks, then my back became aggravated again. The pain was so unbearable that it made daily activities seemingly impossible without medication. I cancelled the next two sessions of physical therapy because of the pain and then later stopped going altogether.

At this point I had become extremely frustrated and slightly depressed. My wife suggested for me to put the Word on it. She gave me a book filled with healing confessions. The book instructed me to make confessions like you take medicine - two to three times per day. It also said to double, triple and quadruple the dosage until I get results (stressing that you cannot OVERDOSE on the Word). Within a couple of days I was doing much better. Clearly the Word was working when nothing else had. I stayed heavy on the healing confessions making them five to six times per day. I got better and better, regaining motion and mobility until finally I was healed. Full manifestation of healing without pain, medications, or limitations!

Spring is here! Time to embrace all that this special season has to offer. One of the best foods packed with vitamin C and antioxidants are strawberries! Strawberries can be used to make a very tasty spring dish. Enjoy this seasonal recipe.

Strawberry, Fennel and Orange Salad



Ingredients

2 navel oranges
8 ounces strawberries (about 16), hulled and quartered or halved
1 fennel bulb, thinly sliced lengthwise, some fronds reserved for garnish
1 1/2 teaspoons fresh lemon juice
1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
1/4 teaspoon coarse salt
Coarsely ground black pepper
8 Boston or Bibb lettuce leaves

Directions

Zest one orange, and reserve zest (2 teaspoons). Cut peel and pith away from both oranges. Use a paring knife to cut out the segments, letting them fall into a bowl, along with the juice.

Add strawberries, sliced fennel, orange zest, and fennel fronds to the bowl of orange segments and toss together gently. Stir in the lemon juice and olive oil, and season with salt and pepper. Add lettuce, toss, and serve.


