FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR DAVID C. FORBES, JR.

In every sport there are all-stars. From football to basketball, baseball, hockey, soccer, you name it. Every sport has all-pro players who are considered to be the best of the best. The things we see in the natural are just reflections of what's taking place in the spirit. So, there must also be spiritual all-stars and supernatural all-stars. We're going to talk about these all-stars. I want you to know who they are, what they have to work with, what makes them great and what makes them all-stars.

The first all-stars are God's angels. The second all-stars are us, believers. On earth, God is working with breakthrough believers and He's using angels. Part of our package, part of our victory, assurance and guarantee, is that the angels of God are fighting and standing on our behalf. When you understand that, you are energized to walk in your breakthrough status.

Psalm 103 is the Psalm of Blessing, and verse 20 says, "Bless the Lord ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word."

There are four points to understand about angels:

1. **They bless the Lord** – They are very loyal and faithful to God.
2. **They excel in strength** – They are very, very strong.
3. **They do God's commandments** – They are obedient, and their will is to do what God says.
4. **They hearken unto the voice of God's Word** – They respond when you speak what God speaks.

God has assigned angels to minister to us:

1. They are sent forth to minister to those that are heirs of salvation (Hebrews 1:13-14).
Somebody is sending them, dispatching them and assigning them.
2. They strengthen us after a spiritual attack (Matthew 4:1-11).
The first agents of triage are the angels. They are there to meet your needs whether they are physical, mental, emotional, internal or external, financial or health-related.
3. They speak to humans as God leads (Luke 1:28-37).
God sends angels to deliver messages, give us understanding and get us back on track.
4. They are able to bend earthly circumstances in favor of God's plan (Numbers 22:21-35).

May the angels of God come in your life and blow stuff up that doesn't belong! Everything that does not belong, let it disintegrate right now. I speak it over you and over myself as well in Jesus Name!



Kids In Christ's Kingdom

Innovation and technology are helping enhance the Children's Ministry here at CCC. Beginning December 2013, Kids In Christ's Kingdom (K.I.C.K.) will implement a new registration system called **KidCheck**.

The new system will:

- 1) *Increase Efficiency* – Your child's information will always be up-to-date, and age-related classroom shifts will be easier.
- 2) *Increase Speed* – Once a child's account is created by the parent/guardian, it will take less than a minute to check-in your child.
- 3) *Increase Safety* – A different number is generated at each check-in; parents will also be able to provide additional information if needed during each check-in.

The new mobile check-in system will be stationed on the first floor near the elevator.

The system updates the number of children registered for each class, alerting the ministry workers in real-time of teacher/child ratios. By knowing class ratios right away, the ministry lead has an opportunity to enlist additional volunteers as needed. Thanks to the new **KidCheck** system, families have a new, efficient, expedited and improved way to register their children into K.I.C.K.



9. Dancing in the Spirit
10. Singing in the Spirit
11. Run in the Spirit

1 quart of dairy eggnog or canned eggnog
1-2 10 ounce bottles (1-1/4 to 2-1/2 cups) ginger ale,
chilled

DIRECTIONS

- a. Place ice cream in a large chilled bowl; stir until softened. Gradually stir in eggnog.
- b. Transfer to a punch bowl; add desired amount of ginger ale to achieve desired consistency. For garnish, top each serving with additional peppermint ice cream and peppermint sticks. Makes 18 (4-ounce) servings.

ALMOND CRANBERRY SQUASH BAKE

INGREDIENTS

4 cups mashed cooked butternut squash
4 tablespoons butter, softened, divided
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1/4 teaspoon ground allspice
1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
1 can (14 ounces) whole-berry cranberry sauce
1/2 cup sliced almonds
1/4 cup packed brown sugar

DIRECTIONS

In a large bowl, combine the squash, 2 tablespoons butter, salt, cinnamon, allspice and nutmeg. Transfer to a greased 2-quart baking dish. Stir cranberry sauce until softened; spoon over squash.

Combine the almonds, brown sugar and remaining butter; sprinkle over cranberry sauce. Bake, uncovered at 350 degrees for 50-60 minutes or until golden brown and bubbly.
