# GO DEEPER IN WORK TO THE PORT OF THE PORT

FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR DAVID C. FORBES, JR.

I want you to experience a new side of God through your worship. Real worship opens God's heart, opens your heart and opens heaven. It gears you up to receive things that are not ordinary (things from the supernatural realm).

Worship causes open-heart surgery. It compels you to change and get back on the same page with God; where you and the Holy Spirit are in agreement. David was a man after God's own heart. Why? Because he was a worshipper. David knew worship pleased God.

# "The Father seeketh such to worship Him."

Our passionate worship opens God's heart to us and our hearts to His. It causes us to see God as He is. When you worship God, you become fully persuaded that anything is possible, just like Abraham was fully persuaded.

This type of worship, real worship, positions us to live under an open heaven. When heaven opens, manifestations, miracles, signs and wonders show up. That's when you know you've moved from Faith and the Anointing into the Glory – the manifested presence of God.

John 4:23-24 says, "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth."

When you worship God properly (in spirit and in truth), you loose God to work on your behalf, and you paralyze Satan. You become out of Satan's reach. Satan may try to reach for you, but he can't touch you because God builds a fence around you.

Learn how to transition from high praise to deep, genuine worship. As you do, you will experience an intimate relationship with God. Remember, the purpose of intimacy is to conceive. God is looking to manifest through you, all that He is, all that He has and all that He can do. He wants to share His secrets and revelations with you.

So today I invite you to go deeper in worship. Lift up your hands and open your mouth in thanksgiving, praise and worship to our Heavenly Father. Come into His house with explosive expectation. When we worship God on one accord, anything can happen! Let's go deeper!

### **DEACONS**

The Deacons are an extension of Pastor David C. Forbes, Jr. and play a vital role in caring for the saints of CCC. Whether ministering to CCC members or preaching the Word, Deacons are truly Breakthrough Believers.

#### What is a Deacon?

Pastor has taught us that the term Deacon comes from the Greek root word "Diakonos" which is translated as servant, minister or administrator. The first reference in scripture to anyone operating in the capacity of a Deacon is in Acts 6:1-6, when seven men were appointed to attend to the needs of the Greek and Hebrew widows.

At CCC, Deacons are men and women. Their main purpose is to assist in partner care and administrative duties. Some of their assignments include making hospital visits, praying with members, blessing the new homes of members and caring for the widows within the CCC congregation. They also perform any other duties as assigned by Pastor Forbes.

To qualify as a Deacon, a CCC member must meet the guidelines listed in Acts 6. He or she must be full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, and be of good reputation. Ideally, Deacons are also graduates of the Ever Increasing Life Training Center (EILTC).

### "Deacons are the backbone of CCC."

Because of the commitment and support of Breakthrough Believers like the Deacons, Pastor Forbes is free to spend time before the Lord and receive fresh revelation, which is key to our supernatural lives.

Deacons are the backbone of CCC. Through their heart-felt serving, it is evident that they are the manifestation of Apostolic government and the Culture of Honor in action.





Katherine is a great example of what it means to be a Kingdom minded, breakthrough believer!









#### Two Realms and Three Dimensions

- Two Realms
  - 1. Natural
  - 2. Supernatural


 If you are stuck, it is in the natural. In the supernatural, there is always acceleration over lack, sickness, disease, or anything that causes you not to live the abundant life.

> The supernatural takes care of everything. Once you learn how to walk in the supernatural, you won't have any problems that God cannot solve.

- Three Dimensions
  - 1. Faith
  - 2. Anointing
    - 3. Glory
  - It takes three dimensions to go from the natural to the supernatural.
    - As Christians, we need to learn how to yield, cooperate, participate and respond properly to the Holy Spirit. It is in God's glory that signs, wonders and creative miracles are found. In the glory, impossible and inability must bow its knee.

### **Creating an Atmosphere for Worship**

- To make room for the glory is to allow praise and worship to inundate our lives. Lifting our hands as an expression of surrendering ourselves to God united with words of thankfulness and adoration to Him who loves us so much.
- Praise and worship is an invitation for a visitation by God. To praise is to seek God, to worship is to be found by Him.
- Worship is essential to entering into God's presence and the realm of His glory.



### **Experience the Encounter**

- We are children of a supernatural God, nothing stops Him or keeps Him from functioning.
- When you have revelation, God reveals, uncovers and unfolds something that your eyes and mind can't get to without the Holy Spirit.

### **Recognition of the Reality of Our Identity**

- Expect God to do something out of the ordinary! If you

  to experience things you've never experienced before.
- God is always fresh, and the quickest way into the supernatural is to pray in the spirit.

### The Mystery of God's Glory is Hidden in the Cross


 The Christ who was crucified on the cross is the finished work, and the payment that was made got us back to being Eden carriers. An Eden carrier is someone that carries the presence of God everywhere they go and can make withdrawals supernaturally if necessary.

- The Shekinah glory describes the imminent presence of God that transcends the spiritual realm and manifests in the physical world; that's healing, deliverance and overcoming the impossible!


### A Breakthrough in the Natural to Enter the Supernatural



This is the perfect time to take advantage of the outdoors. Simple outdoor tasks such as raking leaves, mowing and other yard work contribute to your overall health and allow for outdoor enjoyment. Remember to eat only the fruits and vegetables that are in season. In season fruits and vegetables are at their peak nutritional values. Here is a delicious recipe that is packed with nutrients for your family to enJOY.

### **Vegetable-Bean Stew**

### **Ingredients:**

1 tablespoon olive oil

1 cup water

1 medium onion, chopped

2 cloves of garlic crushed w/press

1.5 teaspoons curry powder

1.5 ground cumin

.25 teaspoon salt

1 can 14oz diced tomatoes

12oz carrots, peeled and cut

into 1-inch chunks

12oz parsnips peeled and cut

into 1-inch chunks

1 large zucchini cut into ½-inch

chunks

.25 cup fresh chopped mint leaves 1 can/15oz garbanzo beans

(chickpeas), rinsed and drained



### **Directions:**

In 5 to 6 quart saucepot, heat oil on medium until hot. Add onion and cook 8 to 10 minutes or until tender, stirring occasionally. Stir in garlic, curry, cumin, and ¼ teaspoon salt; cook 30 seconds, stirring. Add tomatoes, broth, beans, carrots, parsnips and water; heat to boiling on medium-high.

Reduce heat to medium; cover and cook 10 minutes. Stir in zucchini; cover and cook 10 to 15 minutes longer until vegetables are tender. Remove sauce pot from heat; stir in mint. ENJOY!

### "Get Revelation"

To reveal something means to make it known. In line with our current understanding, Merriam-Webster's dictionary defines revelation as divine truth that is revealed by God to humans. We may ask, "Why is revelation so important?" Paul knew the importance of revelation in a believer's life and prayed in Ephesians 1:17-18 that the glorious Father, the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, would give us a spirit of wisdom and revelation as we come to know Christ better. Then we will have deeper insight. With revelation we will know the confidence that He calls us to have and the glorious wealth that God's people will inherit. Like Paul, we must come to know that without revelation, our understanding of who God is and what He can do on our behalf is extremely limited.

In Matthew 16, Peter boldly declares that Jesus is the promised Messiah, the Son of God. Jesus replied to his declaration by saying that only God could have revealed that truth to him, and that he, Peter, was blessed for having received it. We see in this account that as a result of Peter's praise and worship of Jesus, revelation and blessing came. Since God doesn't change, His spiritual laws do not change either. Like Peter, we too can receive this same blessing. High praise and deep worship open the door of our understanding to receive divine revelation. The revelation may be instructions on how to get out of a difficult situation, how to respond in the face of rejection, or simply how to walk closer with God. Regardless of the exact knowledge, the result is the same: a deeper understanding of God and a blessing for walking in our Father's revealed truth.

### It is time to go Supernatural with our giving!

- We should never appear before the Lord empty handed. Our seed makes room for us. (Deuteronomy 16:16-17)
- There is no such thing as a small seed!
  Do not sow to impress people. Sow
  to impress the Holy Spirit by being
  obedient. You're going to live the way
  you sow!
- It's time to begin treating the seed just like we do the harvest. Take the time to pray and ask for your seed.
- Pray, "Lord, increase my seed."
- Our Faith, anointing and glory covers our finances. Faith is what gets the process started.
- Faith is a seed of glory. In order to plant faith we must say it. Increasing faith is the same as increasing the Glory. Sowing by itself does not make increase, the glory makes increase!


